


The Dominican Republic has become an attractive nearshoring center for manufacturing and distribution to the United States, Latin American and Caribbean markets

The # of companies (industrial & manufacturing) operating in free zones across the DR has risen from 602 in 2013 to 820 in 2023





### Moor Master:


Automated system with mooring units for ship berthing. San Antonio is the first terminal in the region with this system.

In a joint-investment with the Government, DP World in San Antonio is working to include a rail connection directly on the port to connect with other intermodal terminals in Santiago.






#### CALLAO

52% of cargo moved from/to Posorja and Guayaquil is made possible thanks to this system. (22,000 tons CO2 prevented)
