

RMS - The largest U.S. independent intermodal rail ramp operator

- Rail Management Services (RMS) formed in 1987 is a major player in U.S. intermodal terminal services, providing:
- Lift on/off operations
- Trailer/container/chassis repairs for railroads and truckers
- Maintenance of over 80 intermodal top/side picks
- Intermodal administrative services including gate inspections and container yard management
- Vehicle handling services
- Contracts with major Class 1 railroads
- 15.9 million TEUs handled in 2023 at 62 U.S. locations





SUSTAINABILITY



Ambitious company-wide initiatives to reduce carbon emissions and has achieved short term reduction targets ahead of schedule.

To date, highlights from these initiatives have included:

- Electric yard trucks and forklifts throughout North America
- Over 200+ zero emissions equipment in operation globally
- Hybrid and e-RTGs throughout international container terminals
- LED lighting upgrades throughout terminal facilities, leading to energy and carbon savings
- **Solar installations** at terminals in California and Mexico
- Renewable diesel at the majority of California container terminals



SPOTLIGHT ON MANZANILLO, MEXICO

Conversion of the entire fleet of RTG from diesel to electric at its container terminal in Manzanillo, Mexico

- Massive Investment in zero emissions equipment and advancing decarbonization in the maritime industry
- Scale of this initiative: 52 e-RTGs:
 40 in 2020 + 12 in 2022
- Prevented the emission of over 16,300 tons of CO₂ in the same year, marking a significant step toward more sustainable operations for SSA Marine






NEW AMBITIONS

(million TEUs)




Americas 2023 Equity Throughput
