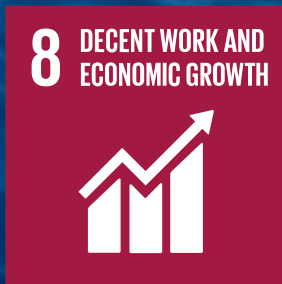

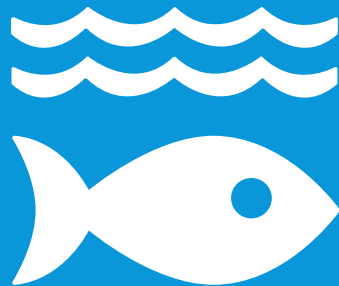

SDG 14: Life Below Water


- **Proposal:** Implement sustainable management practices to protect marine ecosystems.
